 - Sickness prescription: a) Enlist others
 - b) Pray
 - c) Anoint with oil
 - -Ancient meds? (cf.Lk.10:34).
 - God is not last resort but the One we constantly look to...
- v.15—"prayer of faith"...verbs seem to point to a deeper cure (ie. save, raise, forgive)...
- v.16a—Taking seriously sin in sickness...
 - We are broken creatures who do broken things in a broken world...
