Intro: August...back to the books of school.

- New series to study the Books of Scripture...
- Why believe the Bible and other questions on this God-breathed Book...

The Scripture on Scripture

Read: Jeremiah 30:1-2

- Over 2,000x a phrase like “thus says the Lord” is written (cf. Jer.30)...
 - Divine authorship w/ human involvement.

Read: Matthew 5:17-18, 4:4

- Jesus’ high view of Scripture—it’s the bank and bread for believers...
 - Spiritually struggling apart from Scripture’s sustenance!

Read: Isaiah 50:10-11

- Note direction—from heaven with earthly application...
- Budding and blossoming work of Bible...

Read: 2 Peter 1:19-21

- A lamp that lights the way.
- The Spirit spark in the mark...

Read: 2 Timothy 3:14-17

- “Inspired by God” literally “God-breathed”: not good book but a God book!
- God comes close when we come to His Word/breathe!
- Profitable purposes: teaching, reproof, correction, training...

Reasons why the Bible is God’s Breathe

1) Breathing thru the P _____

- God writes His story in HIStory—people, places, events as evidence (cf. Acts 26:26).

- Historical events once doubted now excavated...

-Over 25,000 finds in archeology corresponding to Biblical history!

2) Breathing thru the P _____

- 40 authors, 3 languages, multiple millennia and cultures—one unified Book!
- Text evidence: more manuscripts, closer to originals than other historical documents...
 - Dead Sea Scrolls and scribal accuracy...

3) Breathing thru P _____

- Not just writing thru history but predicting *specifically* future history (Acts 26:27)...
- *Specific* prophecies fulfilled...

4) Breathing thru the P _____ (aka Jesus)

- Mathematic impossibility of one man fulfilling OT Messianic prophecy...
- This Book points to Jesus (cf. Lk.24:27).

5) Breathing thru P _____

- Variety in Scripture not only in authorship but also genre (narrative, prophecy, poetry, wisdom, gospels, epistles, apocalyptic)...
 - Getting message to masses in multiple modes...

6) Breathing thru the P _____

- Creation, Fall, Rescue, Consummation.
- Unique storyline of Scripture...grace, not good works!

7) Breathing thru P _____ Experience

- Scripture penetrates the human experience if we are willing to take the sword from the sheath (cf. Heb.4:12).

Closing: Evidences behind inspiration...not just a good book but a God-breathed Book!
