
v.19-21—Intro to a "gatekeeper"...Lazarus.

- Contrast of characters...
- v.22-23—Something in common...death.
- Contrasting destinations...
  - -Abraham's bosom vs. Hades torment
- v.24—Merciless now requesting mercy...
- v.25-26—Abraham's response: choices and chasms...
- v.27-28—First request outside himself but still his family...
- v.29—God's answer in Moses/prophets...
- v.30-31—Anticipation of what Jesus will do.

## **GateKeeper's General Guide**

- 1) The R from this Life
- GateKeeper's 180 degree rotation...many who are first will be last (cf. Mt.19:28-30).
- The problem isn't riches but a relationship (cf. Lk.16:13)...Lazarus's name!
  - -Jesus' interaction with the rich (Lk.8:3).
  - -Abraham a man of means (Gen.13:2).
- 2) The R\_\_\_\_\_ of the Afterlife
  - Hell isn't trendy but truthful.
  - Jesus tells of Hell more than any other in Scripture (Mt.7:13-14, 8:10-12, 13:41-43, 49-51, 25:41ff.).
- 3) The R\_\_\_\_\_ of God's Ruling
- A loving God entails life with choices...
- The rich man's choice (v.25—"you/your")
- The choice of God to give every chance (v.30 and Jesus' resurrection)...

**Closing:** The GateKeeper experience hinges on Jesus (Jn. 10:3-5, 9-10).

Read: Acts 3

\*What do you observe about the early church in Acts?

\*What spoke to you this past Sunday (ie. what made you laugh, learn, look deeper at life etc.)?

\*The Bible uses a specific verbs to communicate Lazarus's posture as "lay." What word would you use to describe the current posture of your life (ie. laying, standing, waiting, running etc.)? Explain.

\*It seems the parable assumes the rich man lacked being a sharing man. How did you/do you teach your children to share or how were you taught to share?

\* Lazarus was laid right outside the gate, so the rich man had plenty of opportunities. Are there things right outside our doors as a church we should be doing? In your neighborhood?

\*Is there anything in the past that you thought God was telling you to do but you didn't listen?

\*This is the time for haunted houses, many of them seem to be about the afterlife, like the 7 floors of hell haunted house. What do you think of when you think about the afterlife based on Lk. 16:24-31, Matthew passages in sermon, and/or Rev. 20-22?
