 - THE serpent (Rev.12:9)...cast to earth continuing deception and rebellion...
- v.1—Slithery, subtle, snake-like attack...
- **v.1b-3**—Personal boundaries added to God's boundaries ("not touch it" cf. 2:16-17).
- **v.4-5**—Serpent's split tongue challenge...
- v.6—Focused on object rather than on God...
- **v.7**—Sewing leaves: manmade solutions can't solve sin issue!
- **v.8-9**—God's not giving up...
 - A question for reflection and confession...
- **v.10**—Sin opened a new reality...
- v.11-13—Blame shifting, shallow confessing.
- v.14-19—Consequences of man's choices...
 - First Messianic clue v.15...

- **v.20-21**—Garments meant the grave...OT sacrifices and prefiguring Christ (Jn.1:29)...
- **v.22-24**—Hardest thing in the moment is the best thing in the long run (cf. Rev.22)...
