

**Intro:** Last week, lessons on opportunities as we studied the intro of David vs. Goliath...

- **v.31-32**—Notice how often "heart" ties into the story of David, a man after God's own heart (Acts 13:22)...
- **v.33-37**—David's the only one who factored God in the battle plans...
- **v.38**—Trying to out Goliath a Goliath when what we really need is God!
- **v.39-40**—Epic battles aren't times to try to be someone you are not...
- v.41-44—The disdain and dialogue...
- "cursed David by his gods"...more than just a military maneuver...
- v.45-47—David sets record straight...
  - David realizes reality (v.45a), yet prophetically proclaims God's victory (v.46-47).
- v.48-54—Anti-climactic battle: lots of lead up but one stone, one stab and the rest is history! v.55-58—How the no-namer becomes a household name...

## **Lessons from the Heart (Acts 13:22)**

- Notice the words of David and what they reveal about his faith...
  - -v.26: optimistic, concerned for others, God's omnipotence.
  - -v.37: God's faithfulness confidence for future deliverance.
