**Intro:** Studying the life of Simon Peter...


- Word of the Year from Peter and next words (Matt. 16:13-23)...
- The disciple with the foot-shaped mouth...
- **v.1**—Making the most of final moments...
  - Jesus serving others rather than selfpitying in the final seconds of life...
- v.2-5—In antiquity, feet are filthy! Jesus cleans that with is filthy!!!
- **v.6**—Peter breaks the silence...
- **v.7**—Not all is grasped in the immediate...
- **v.8**—A washing symbolic for the deeper cleansing of Christ...
- **v.9-11**—After a total cleansing, only contaminated area needs washed...
- Role of confession (keeping clean) after the initial "bath" in Jesus...
- v.12-17—A word on service and example...
- v.18-30—Calling out betrayal...
- v.31-35—Final teachings...
- v.36-37—Peter's question and claim...
- **v.38**—Jesus warns roots of betrayal is even found in him!!!
- Surprised by our sin (cf.1Cor.10:12)...
- Progression doesn't mean perfection...

## LESSON:

- Context of lesson: cleansing administered by Christ (ie. footwashing)!
- Jesus came to show a forgiving God!!! (ie. Adam/Eve, Prodigal Son, Peter's journey).

\*Reflect on the image of God bowing to scrub dirty feet when Jesus washed the disciples' feet... What emotion does this trigger when you consider Jesus?

\*One of Jesus' last acts was washing His disciples feet. What is one act of service someone else has done for you that left a lasting impact on you?
