

Read: John 9 *From this passage, who is Jesus and/or what's this say about life in Him (cf. Jn.20:30-31)?

*What spoke to you this past Sunday (ie. what made you laugh, learn, look deeper at life etc.)?

*What's your first church memory ever (ie. how old, what happened, etc.)? Why do you think God's seared that moment in your mind? And did you learn anything significant about God or life because of that event?

*What was your first impression of FUMC the first time you attended here?

*What most caught your attention about the new addition dedication, and/or what was one historical detail about this church since the 1800s that interested you?

*In your <u>opinion</u>, what's the most sacred space of the church? (NOTE: This is an opinion question. We know God can and does make even random bushes sacred meeting spots (cf. Ex.3), so I'm not asking for a fine tuned theological response but just a personal sentiment.)
