*Read: John 19*

*\*From this passage, who is Jesus and/or what’s this say about life in Him (cf. Jn.20:30-31)?*

*\*What spoke to you this past Sunday (ie. what made you laugh, learn, look deeper at life etc.)?*

*\*Last Day Question: In this week’s sermon we looked at “Jesus’ deathbed.” If you had the power to could choose the circumstances of your death, how would you die, who is around you, what are your last words? In other words, what would be your “ideal death”?*

*\*Last Week Question: What do you notice about the way Jesus dies that’s worthy of emulation? In other words, how does Jesus teach about a “good death” thru His process of dying on the cross?*

*\*Present Moment Question: If there is a connection between a good death and a good life, what area of my life is currently not good that I need to intentionally bring before God? Any hidden sins, broken relationships, waste of time events, etc that needs addressed before my death? List. (Note: This question may or may not be asked as part of group time but is still important to do some personal digging in!)*
