**v.19-21**—Jesus' economic lesson...earthly vs. eternal...

- Our heart follows our treasure...
- v.22-23—Training the eyes...
  - Our gaze sets our goings...
- **v.24-34**—"Keep your eye on the ball" kind of teachings from Jesus...

## Putting the Ball in Play the Matthew 6 Way

- 1) \_\_\_\_\_v.25, 32
  - God made us with these basic needs and so He knows our needs...
- He also knows what needs are bigger than even the basics!
- Keeping the Main Thing the Main Thing and not getting lost in other things...
- 2) \_\_\_\_\_cf. Lk.19:10
- We seek because He first sought...
- Story of Christianity is that God sought you out!
- y.33
  - seek/search/pursue...effort is involved!
  - Spiritual disciplines of giving, praying, fasting (v.1-18) factor into seeking (v.33).
