## The Christian Pursuit

1) "Pressing on" takes P

- No one lands in Olympics without prepping their skill...
- Our walk with God doesn't come natural...we are "sinful" not "skillful" from the start (cf. Ps. 51:5).
- Learning to run with God takes intentional/disciplined practice!
- 2) "Pressing on" onward P
  - The Christian journey is in front of us...
  - Danger in running when we look back or look over our shoulder...run your race!
  - "windshields are bigger than your rearview mirror for a reason...live forward!"
- 3) "Pressing on" includes P\_
  - "straining" reminds us following Jesus ain't easy!
  - Olympic 4-year path paved with adversity...how much more an eternal path?!!
- "No pain, no gain!"
- 4) "Pressing on" for the P
- The only enduring prize (cf.1Cor.9:24-25).
- The One who won so we can win...

<u>Philippians 3:12-14</u> NIV

<sup>12</sup> Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. <sup>13</sup> Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.
