Matthew 27:11-26 Read: 2 Thessalonians 2-3 \*From this passage, what do you notice about how Pilate's Background Christians are to live? \*What spoke to you this past Sunday (ie. what made you laugh, learn, look deeper at life, etc.)? Trial of Jesus (v.11-18) \*Next week (Palm Sunday) begins Holy Week! How would you explain Holy Week to a co-worker asking you, "What's so 'holy' about this week?" Pilate's Wife's Dreams (v.19-20) \*Is there something you are particularly looking forward to for Holy Week this year? And/or what's one meaningful tradition you have around this holiday season? \*Pilate's a person in a position of authority. Name **Pilate Washing His Hands (v.21-26)** one authority figure you respect. Why do you respect them? \*Pilate's wife had some advice he ignored, which he probably later regretted. Is there any advice you received that you regret for not following? Pilate Post-Crucifixion (v.57-66) \*Name one positive influence of small groups on your life this past year. (And don't forget to fill out the year end evaluation!!!)
