## **Understanding Adoption...**

1) Adoption means

- Adoption often arises out of adverse circumstances (aka "hard knocks")...
- 2) Adoption means
  - Adoption is often pricey, time consuming, lots of hoops, and then when you finally get the child, the work is far from over!
  - God's adopted us—He paid the expense, put in the time, and is willing to go thru the process to mature children into saints!
- 3) Adoption means
  - Biological parents have no say in the baby in the womb, but adopted kids are hand selected, wanted!
- 4) Adoption means
  - Biblically an inheritance tied to an adoption.
