**Intro:** Last week, Paul's first missionary travels: work ethic, witness, way with people...

Read: Acts 15

- Important church meeting known as the Jerusalem Council (~50 AD)...
- v.1—A question of salvation...
  - Saved by man's works or God's work???
  - Do Christians have to become Jews first before following Jesus???
- **v.1-5**—Bigger issue than just Antioch...Paul and Barnabas sent to Jersualem for answers.
- **v.6-7a**—Key issue with all the key leaders present for the debate...
- v.7-11—Peter's experience (cf. Acts 10-11)...
- **v.12-21**—Applying Bible to debate (v.16-18)...
  - Lesson on Christians and civil discourse...
- **v.22-35**—Consensus reached (v.25) and steps to keep the peace in early church (v.29)...
- **v.36**—Return trip to see churches originally planted...
- v.37-41—Paul and Barnabas part ways?!!!

## **Lessons on Church Councils and Conflicts**

- Jesus alone saves...but steps to keeping the peace.


- Only One is sinless...it's not Paul!
